ANNOUNCEMENT OF PUBLIC HEARING AND INVITATION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON THE PAULDING COUNTY'S APPROVED ACTIVITIES

UNDER THE NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION PROGRAM 3

Paulding County in corporation with the Northwest Georgia Regional Commission will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, December 13, 2011 for the purpose of discussing the approved activities under the HUD Neighborhood Stabilization Program 3 (NSP3). The public hearing will be held at 6:00 PM. at the Paulding County Government Complex Administration Building Cafeteria, 1st Floor 240 Constitution Blvd. Dallas, GA 30132.

On March 11, 2011 the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) awarded Paulding County a grant in the amount of \$1,372,214 to administer the Neighborhood Stabilization Program 3 (NSP3). Through the NSP3, Paulding County will partner with the Northwest Georgia Regional Commission to assist in the redevelopment of abandoned and foreclosed homes in areas designated by HUD.

Items to be discussed at the Hearing include:

- The amount of funds received and a description of the approved activities.
- The amount of funds available for each activity and the amount of funds that will benefit low, moderate and middle income families and individuals.
- The plan to minimize or prevent displacement of persons and the plan to assist persons who may be displaced.
- Fair housing laws and Paulding County's plan to further Fair Housing.

The Public is invited to attend this Hearing to become informed of the project activities.
