

The Georgia Department of Transportation Title VI Program ensures no person shall be excluded from participation in, or is denied the benefits of, or is subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance from the Department of Transportation on the grounds of race, color, age, sex, disability or national origin.

Within the past year many of the local cities and counties have received information from the Georgia Department of Transportation Title VI. Many of you have had to sign Title VI assurance documents in order to ensure federal funding for your road construction projects. However, many may still not understand the requirements of Title VI and how it affects local governments. To that end, The Georgia Department of Transportation personnel will provide a comprehensive training class targeting Title VI and ADA roles, responsibilities and duties for federal aid sub-recipients, i.e. local governments free of charge. Since the Georgia Department of Transportation will begin auditing all sub-recipients for Title VI and ADA compliance within six to eight months following training, your attendance is required and compliance protects current and future federal funding.
